Day 01: MNL A/P - AMM A/P VIA EK (D) :

Arrival AMM A/P with, transfer to Amman. Then around noon time begin you visit of Amman; prepare yourself for special day, as we will begin by visiting Amman the Capital of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan by visiting National Museum , Citadel, then walk though Down Town and visit Roman Theater. **Dinner & Overnight in AMMAN.**

Day 02: JERASH – UMM QUIESS (B/D) :

After Breakfast, driving north of Jordan. To the most impressive Greco-Roman City Jerash (Gerassa), known as the Pompeii of the east. Here at well-watered site in the hills of Gilead, there are remains from Neolithic times, as well as Greek, Roman and Omayyad. After the visit to Jerash drive to Umm Queiss, (Roman Gadara), This site commands magnificent views over the northern Jordan Valley. The city was established in the Hellenistic Period and was a strategic trading town for over 1000 years. From the ancient remains is the black basalt theatre, the basilica, and the colonnaded main street with two paths. Return to Amman.

Dinner and Overnight in Amman.

Day 03: BAPTISM SITE – MADABA – Mt. NEBO - TIBERIAS (B/D) :

After Breakfast, drive to the most holy site in Jordan, the site of John the Baptist's settlement at Bethany Beyond the Jordan, where Jesus was baptized, has long been known from the Bible (John 1:28 and 10:40) and from the Byzantine and medieval texts. The site has now been identified on the east bank of the Jordan River, in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, and is being systematically surveyed, excavated, restored, and prepared to receive pilgrims and visitors. Bethany Beyond the Jordan is located half an hour by car from the Jordanian capital Amman. The Bethany area sites formed part of the early Christian pilgrimage route between Jerusalem, the Jordan River, and Mount Nebo. Drive to Madaba to visit St. George's Greek Orthodox Church in Madaba, which was rebuilt in 1897. The world of mosaic map by an unknown mosaicist who worked in Madaba towards the middle of the Sixth Century AD. It is the oldest preserved and most detailed ancient map of the lands extending east and west of the River Jordan from Lebanon to Egypt, from the desert to the Mediterranean. Then drive Mt. Nebo (Siyagha) is the memorial of Prophet Moses. The memorial consists of a Trefoil Church built in the 4th century AD and is famous for having been visited by the Pilgrim In the 5th century AD, a nave was added to the Trefoil Church. In the sixth century, around 530 AD, . Drive to Sheikh Hussein Border. cross to Holy Land.

Dinner & Overnight in Tiberias.

Day 04: Nazareth – Lake of Tiberias – Mt Tabor (B/D) :

After breakfast, you will move onto Lake Tiberias, one of the main places of Jesus' activities including it being the place he called his first disciples. A day immersed in Biblical significance on the Galilee and on the shores of Lake Tiberias, is a fascinating journey through time, reuniting you with events that have shaped and will forever shape the history of our civilization. Around the lake you will visit the beautiful church of Tabgha which is remembered because of the miracle of the multiplication of loaves, and the Mount of Beatitudes and Capernaum, with the house of St. Peter. Visit to Cana of Galilee and to Nazareth, another major site of biblical significance, visit the Basilica of the Annunciation. **Dinner and overnight in Nazareth.**

Day 05: - Jericho – Dead Sea – Qumran - Bethlehem (B/D) :

After breakfast, depart for a green oasis near the Dead Sea- Jericho - which was made famous by the discovery at Tel es-Sultan, of one of the oldest cities of the Levant dating from the eighth millennium BC. Near here you will find the Inn of the Good Samaritan, visit the Mount Quarantine. Then drive to the Dead Sea, Visit Qumran caves, where the shepherds found the famous Dead Sea Scrolls. After the experience the indescribable feeling of floating on the Dead Sea.

Dinner and Overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 06 : Bethlehem - Jerusalem (B/D) :

After breakfast, the day will be spent visiting holy Jerusalem, at the crossroads of different civilizations where you will come across remains of ancient mosaics and treasures from the Roman and Byzantine period, the Crusaders and the Ottoman Empire to name but a few.

Departure to Ein Karem, visit the Church of the Visitation. This church, beautifully located on the slopes of a rocky hill and shaded by cypresses, is also known as the Church of the Magnificent, in commemoration of the answer Mary gave her cousin Elizabeth in the Gospel episode of the Visitation. Visit Mt Zion, discover other places of significance: Monastery of the Dormition, the cave of the Last Supper and the Tomb of King David. **Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.**

Day 07: Jerusalem – Bethlehem (B/D) :

After breakfast, visit to the Mount of Olives upon which you will come across a wonderful panoramic view of central Jerusalem. You can also visit the Sanctuary of the Ascension, the Franciscan Chapel of Dominus Flevit, the tomb of the Virgin, as well as the Basilica of all Nations, "Gethsemane" and the Church of the Pater Noster. In the Old City you will encounter oriental charm and be plunged into the souk's colorful alleys which take you to the meeting places of the three major monotheistic religions: whether along the Via Dolorosa or the Holy Sepulcher, the Dome of Rock and the Wailing Wall, you will be projected into the past, overwhelmed by its inhabitants' array of experiences, those who have imprinted upon the city their unique religious and architectural marks. **Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.**

Day 08: Bethlehem - Jericho – ALLENBY BRIDGE – PETRA (B/D) :

After breakfast, continue tour to Bethlehem ; Basilica of Nativity ; the oldest church in the world which was built over cave that goused Christ at his birth, you will see the Chapel of St. Jerome (who translated Bible into Latin), then Church of St. Catherine and Milk grotto, Later on transfer to Allenby Bridge ,crossing back to Jordan, continue to Petra. **Dinner & Overnight in Petra.**

Day 09: PETRA - AMMAN (B/D) :

After breakfast, full day tour to the ancient city of Petra. Once the stronghold of the gifted Nabateans, an early Arab people. Petra was renowned for its massive architecture and the ingenuity of its pools, dams, and water channels. After going through a narrow gorge (the Siq) the visitor finds himself face to face with the tall façade called the Treasury (Al-Khazneh), the most famous monument in Petra. After the .drive to Amman .**Dinner and overnight in Amman.**

Day 10: TRANSFER TO AMM A/P - DXB A/P (B) :

Transfer to Amman Airport. Flight to Dubai.

Upon Arrival at Dubai Airport. Meet & Greet on Arrival by English Speaking Airport Representative. Transfer to Hotel by Coach. **Overnight in Dubai.**

Day 11: DUBAI - HALF DAY CITY TOUR - HALF DAY DESERT SAFARI (B/L/D) :

Breakfast at hotel. 09:00 You will be collected from your hotel for **Half Day City Tour of Dubai**. You get to enjoy the historical sites and the vibrant cosmopolitan life of Dubai on this tour. Beginning with a photo-stop at the 7-star wonder of the world, the Burj Al Arab, you then proceed to Jumeirah, the picturesque palace and residential area of Dubai; also home to the famous Jumeirah Mosque and Sheikh Saeed's House (the former residence of the ruling family). You are then transported back in time as you visit Al Bastakiya, the old part of Dubai where the museum is located at Al Fahidi Fort. Enjoy a trip across the creek in an abra (water taxi) to the spice souk before savoring the sights and sounds of the fruit and vegetable market, with the final stop to shop at Dubai's famous landmark, the Gold souk. **Lunch at Local Restaurant in Dubai.**

15:30 You will be collected from your hotel for **Half Day Desert Safari with BBQ Dinner**. The mysterious Arabian Desert is the venue for this magical, must-do evening. Leaving behind the crowds and the city, our safari guides in rugged 4x4 vehicles lead the thrilling journey - over towering sand dunes, deep into the heart of the desert. As the sun casts its glow over the soft sands, a traditional welcome awaits at the Bedu camp. Inside the camp, the many traditions of local hospitality revive memories of the Arabian Nights with Bedouin-style seating, aromatic water pipes, camel rides, traditional Arabic attire, and henna designers. To top the evening's entertainment, belly dancing is accompanied by Arabian music. The sumptuous dinner BBQ under the stars includes a Middle Eastern repast of grilled meats, fresh salads, sweets and beverages. After an adventurous tour transfer to hotel.

Overnight in Dubai.

Day 12: DUBAI - FULL DAY TOUR ABU DHABI (B/L/D) :

Breakfast at hotel. 09:00 You will be collected from your hotel lobby for a **Full Day City Tour of Abu Dhabi**. The two hour drive from Dubai to Abu Dhabi takes in the world's largest man made port at Jebel Ali, and stunning vistas of desert roads, acacia trees, rugged terrain, and blue waters. The capital of the UAE has quaint contrasts that are visible in its skyscrapers, villas, mosques and palaces, and along its Riviera-like breakwaters. The majestic Sheikh Zayed Mosque is the third largest in the world, and a marvelous example of Islamic architecture. At the Sheikh Zayed Museum and at the Heritage Village close by, Abu Dhabi's nomadic past is brought alive through traditional fishing villages, colorful souks, craft shops and palm frond houses. **Lunch at a Local Restaurant in Abu Dhabi.**

The magnificent Emirates Palace is a national landmark and one of the most impressive hotels in the world. The trip includes photo stops at the cultural hub of Saadiyat Island – Manarat Al Saadiyat and at Yas Island - home of Ferrari World Abu Dhabi as well as the Yas Marina Formula 1 Race circuit. **Dinner at a Local Restaurant in Dubai. Back to hotel. Overnight in Dubia.**

Day 13: DUBAI A/P - MNL A/P VIA EK (B) :

Breakfast at hotel. Free time until departure transfer to Dubai International Airport by coach.
