Day 01: AMM A/P – TOUR OF AMMAN - AMMAN:

Arrival AMM A/P transfer to Amman. **Dinner & Overnight in Amman**

Day 02: BAPTISM SITE – MADABA – Mt. NEBO –MEKAWER- AMMAN:

After Breakfast, drive to the most holy site in Jordan, the site of John the Baptist's settlement at Bethany Beyond the Jordan, where Jesus was baptized, has long been known from the Bible (John 1:28 and 10:40) and from the Byzantine and medieval texts. The site has now been identified on the east bank of the Jordan River, in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, and is being systematically surveyed, excavated, restored, and prepared to receive pilgrims and visitors. Bethany Beyond the Jordan is located half an hour by car from the Jordanian capital Amman. The Bethany area sites formed part of the early Christian pilgrimage route between Jerusalem, the Jordan River, and Mount Nebo. Drive to Madaba to visit St. George's Greek Orthodox Church in Madaba, which was rebuilt in 1897. The world of mosaic map by an unknown mosaicist who worked in Madaba towards the middle of the Sixth Century AD. It is the oldest preserved and most detailed ancient map of the lands extending east and west of the River Jordan from Lebanon to Egypt, from the desert to the Mediterranean. Then drive Mt. Nebo (**Siyagha**) is the memorial of Prophet Moses. The memorial consists of a Trefoil Church built in the 4th century AD and is famous for having been visited by the Pilgrim In the 5th century AD, a nave was added to the Trefoil Church. In the sixth century, around 530 AD, back to Amman. Continue to Meqawer, which is also called (Machaerus). It is the place where Salome danced in exchange for the head of John the Baptist on a platter. Herod the Great built the royal fortress there and the remains of the fortress's walls dominate Meqawer. After visiting Meqawer, After visit drive back to Amman. **Dinner & Overnight in Amman**

Day 03: CITY TOUR OF AMMAN –BETHLEHEM:

After Breakfast, visiting the Capital of Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan which was known in the Bible as Ammon, the ancient Rabbath Ammoun, the Citadel still standing its massive kingdom, then visiting National museum, Theater, and the famous old Byzantine churches, then continue to drive through Allenby Bridge to Holy Land, , after border

formalities cross into Holy Land. Drive up thru the Judean hills to Bethlehem. tour of Bethlehem,. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 04: Bethlehem – Jerusalem – Bethlehem:

After breakfast, the day will be spent visiting holy Jerusalem, at the crossroads of different civilizations where you will come across remains of ancient mosaics and treasures from the Roman and Byzantine period, the Crusaders and the Ottoman Empire to name but a few. In the Old City you will encounter oriental charm and be plunged into the souk's colorful alleys which take you to the meeting places of the three major monotheistic religions: whether along the Via Dolorosa or the Holy Sepulcher, the Dome of Rock, you will be projected into the past, overwhelmed by its inhabitants' array of experiences, those who have imprinted upon the city their unique religious and architectural marks. Visit Mt Zion, discover other places of significance: Monastery of the Dormition, the cave of the Last Supper and the Tomb of King David. **Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Bethlehem.**

Day 05: Bethlehem–Jerusalem:

After breakfast, there is a tour of Bethlehem, This pretty little town in the heart of the hills is home to the Cave of the Nativity where Jesus was born, as well as it being a city which dates back more than three thousand years with many architectural and historical treasures. A stroll through its old streets with its numerous churches and mosques and ancient relics allows you to experience the charm of a small sized town. After visit Jerusalem: visit to the Mount of Olives upon which you will come across a wonderful panoramic view of central Jerusalem. You can also visit the Sanctuary of the Ascension, the Franciscan Chapel of Dominus Flevit, the tomb of the Virgin, as well as the Basilica of all Nations, "Gethsemane" and the Church of the Pater Noster. From here you will arrive in the Old City to walk through the souk.

DAY 06: JERUSALEM – JORDAN -ANJARA -TELL MAR ELIAS-AMMAN:

AFTER BREAKFAST, CROSS THROUGH SHIEKHU HUSSEIN BORDER TO JORDAN THEN BEGIN ANJRA NORTHERN OF JORDAN TO VISIT ONE OF THE MOST FAMOUS CATHOLIC CHURCHES IN JORDAN, THE CHURCH IS VERY FAMOUS OF ITS WOODEN STATUE OF VIRGIN MARIA CARRYING JESUS IN HERE ARMS, THE STATUE ITSELF WAS FOUND IN A CAVE UNDERNEATH THE CHURCH , ACCORDING TO BIBLE ; JESUS ,HIS MOTHER,AND MANY OTHER WOMEN STOPPED IN ANJRA ON THEIR WAY FROM JERUSALEM TO GALILEE.THIS CHURCH WAS IDENTIFIED BY POPE AND VATICAN AS ONE OF THE 5 MAIN SITES FOR PILGRIM TO VISIT IN JORDAN, THE OTHER PILGRIMAGE CATHOLIC SITE IS (TELL MAR ELIAS), THIS SITE IS LOCATED NORTH WEST OF AJLUN ,HERE – ACCORDING TO BIBLE - WAS PROPHET ELIAS (THE HOLY ELIAS) WAS BORN (1KING 17:1...), THE PLACE IS KNOWN AS TELL MAR ELIAS ,THE HILLS THERE ARE HOLLY SITES FOR PILGRIMS ARE VISITING THIS SITE TO REMEMBER PROPHET ELIAS AND TO PRAY THERE. LATER ON DRIVE PACK TO AMMAN. DINNER & OVERNIGHT IN AMMAN.

DAY 07: JERASH – UMM QUIES -AMMAN:

After Breakfast, drive north to about 45 KM. To Jerash one of the best preserved Roman Towns in the world. Its Triumphal Arch, which was built at 129 to honor the visit to Emperor Hadrian just one part of massive building, today you can walk through "Street of Columns", Roman Cardo. The Two Huge Tamales of Zeus and Airtimes and a lot of other different sites. From Petra, drive north to Umm Queiss, historically known Gadara is one of the most unique Greco-Roman Decapolis sites. Umm Queiss is about 378 m above sea level, where it offers a panoramic view **OVER GOLAN ,HEIGHTS/SYRIAN MOUNTAINS AND LAKE OF TIBERIAS, THEN VISITING THE** different site like, Theaters, living quarters, Basilica Terrace, Tomb, and the Church. Later on drive back to Amman. Dinner and overnight **in Amman.**

Day 08: TRANSFER TO AMM A/P.

After Breakfast, Transfer to AMM A/P.
