

Siem Reap (Optional Tour based on private)

Minimum of 2 persons

Optional 1 : Cruise on Tonle Sap and Les Artisans d' Angkor (0800-1130/1400-1700) - Half day – USD45/PERSON

Pick up at the airport or hotel and transfer to **Floating Village** at **Tonle Sap Lake** where people have houses built in the river. Houses floating like the river are the street and the boats the cars. Families, father, and children pass by with their boat. They come home from work, school or they are going shopping in the mini supermarket. Back to town then take time to visit **Les Chan tiers Ecoles Artisans D' Angkor** is a workshop that teaches the unique craft of wood and stone carving in the traditional and style of classic Cambodian artistry. **Wat Thmei, Killing Field**, The wat contains a unique glass-walled stupa containing the bones of victims of the Khmer Rouge. Some of the bones were recovered from a nearby well while others are the remains of soldiers who died on a nearby battlefield.

Optional 2 : Banteay Srei - Ta Prohm Temple (0800-1130/1400-1700) - Half day – USD65/PAX

Pick up at the airport or hotel and transfer to visit **Banteay Srey** loosely translates to 'citadel of the women,' but this is a modern appellation that probably refers to the delicate beauty of the carvings. **Ta Prohm Temple** unlike most of the other Angkor temples, Ta Prohm has been left just it was founded, the photogenic and atmospheric combination of trees growing out of the ruins and the jungle surroundings have made it one of Angkor's most popular temples with visitors.

Optional 3 : Angkor Wat - Angkor Thom Complex - Ta Prohm (0800-1700) - Full day with lunch - USD75/PAX

Pick up at the airport or hotel and transfer to visit **South Gate of Angkor Thom Temple** and marvel the wonders of the eerie **Bayon, Baphoun, Phimeanakas, the Elephants terrace and terrace of Leper King. Ta Prohm Temple** unlike most of the other Angkor temples, Ta Prohm has been left just it was founded, the photogenic and atmospheric combination of trees growing out of the ruins and the jungle surroundings have made it one of Angkor's most popular temples with visitors. Lunch at local reataurant.

PM: Visit the famous **Angkor Wat**, built for king Suryavarman II in the early 12th century as his state temple and capital city. The largest and best-preserved temple at the site, it is the only one to have remained a significant religious center—first Hindu, then Buddhist—since its foundation.

Optional 4 : Kbal Spean (trekking) – Banteay Srey & Roluos Gorup (0800-1700) - Full day with lunch – USD93/PAX

Pick up at the airport or hotel and transfer to visit **Kbal Spean** is an ancient Angkor ruin that is a 90-minute bumpy ride from Siem Reap, on the same route to Banteay Srei. There are carvings of Buddha and Buddhist images in the rock that date from a later period than the lingas. It requires a moderately easy 45-minute uphill walk through the woods. Then we will spend about half hour journey to reach **Banteay Srey**, one of the most unusual temples of Angkor, Cambodia. It lies 20 km due north of the main group. It is built largely of red sandstone, which is covered with elaborate and deeply carved decoration. Lunch will be served at local restaurant.

PM: Visit **The Roluos Group** is a collection of monuments representing the remains of Hariharalaya, the first major capital of the Angkorian-era Khmer Empire. It has become known as the 'Roluos Group' due to its proximity to the modern town of Roluos.
